Who is Eligible

The Preferred Partnership option is available in the St. Louis area to nonunion employees and their covered dependents; and employees represented by International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 1; International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 6; International Association of Fire Firefighters, IAFF Local I-66 — St. Louis (Firefighters); and their covered dependents.

Retirees of the groups listed above and their dependents are also eligible if not covered by Medicare, plus retirees formerly represented by International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 610 and their covered dependents. Those covered by Medicare are not eligible for the Preferred Partnership option.
